The block-grant for **NURSING 2000 SCHOLARSHIPS** are awarded to Indiana University School of Nursing, Ivy Tech Community College Program of Nursing, Marian University School of Nursing, and the University of Indianapolis School of Nursing and will be administered by the school to undergraduate or graduate degree students. Each School of Nursing shall select the Nursing 2000 scholarship recipients and distribute the award money.

ELIGIBILITY

The **NURSING 2000 SCHOLARSHIP** will be awarded to candidates who meet the following minimum qualifications:

Criteria

1. Indiana resident
2. Attendance at one of the affiliated Schools of Nursing in the eleven county area
3. Full-time or part-time student in nursing major
4. Competitive GPA
5. Financial need is considered
6. Enrolled in undergraduate or graduate program
7. Demonstrates a commitment to work in nursing in the eleven county area upon graduation

Consideration is given to all applicants without regard to age, gender, race, creed, or national origin.

Nursing 2000 requests that the selection of the candidates be approved by the Dean of the School of Nursing or designate. The organization also requests to be notified regarding the candidates selected with a brief biography. A report, from the Dean to the Executive Director of Nursing 2000, describing the distribution of the monies is required.
